

THE NORTHWEST HILLS RITS PROGRAM

What is it?

The RITS Program provides non-emergency medical trips for the elderly and disabled.

Who is it for?

Depending on what town you live in, either Geer, Northwestern CT Transit District, EdAdvance, the Sullivan Center will provide the transportation services.

Where can I go?

The trips need to begin or end in one of the Northwest Hills town (all pictured on map). Rides are available to and from medical facilities outside of the region such as Yale New Haven or UConn Medical Center.

How much does it cost?

NHCOG funds the program. There is no cost to the user. Donations are accepted.

How do I use it?

Call your designated provider (*see next page*) and arrange for your ride as soon as you schedule your medical appointment. Calls should be made at least 48 hours in advance. This service is generally available Monday - Friday from 8 am - 6 pm.
